RESCHEDULED: PORTION OF ROUTE 134 SOUTHBOUND CLOSED OVERNIGHT STARTING MONDAY

Signed detours will be in place next week

YORK COUNTY/HAMPTON— The previously scheduled detour on Route 134 southbound is now estimated to begin on Monday, Sept. 14 at 7 p.m. A portion of Route 134 (Magruder Boulevard / Hampton Highway) southbound near the bridge over Brick Kiln Creek is scheduled to closed for utility work as follows, weather permitting:

- Monday, Sept. 14 from 7 p.m. to 5 a.m. Tuesday, Sept. 15,
- Tuesday, Sept. 15 from 7 p.m. to 5 a.m. Wednesday, Sept. 16, and
- Wednesday, Sept. 16 from 7 p.m. to 5 a.m. Thursday, Sept. 17.

Signed detours will be in place and local traffic will have access to the last entrance before the bridge. Those travelling southbound on Route 134 will be detoured to Route 600 (Big Bethel Road) and continue through Semple Farm Road to end at Route 134.

All work is weather-dependent, and the schedule is subject to change.
