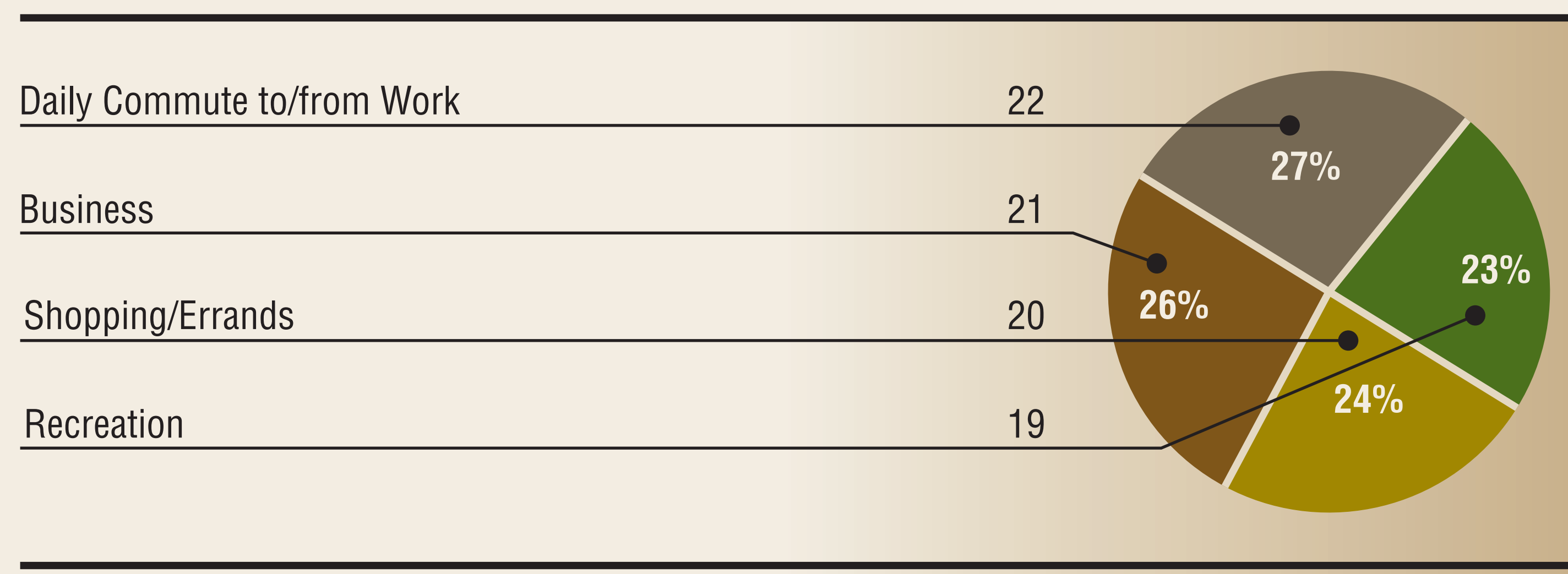

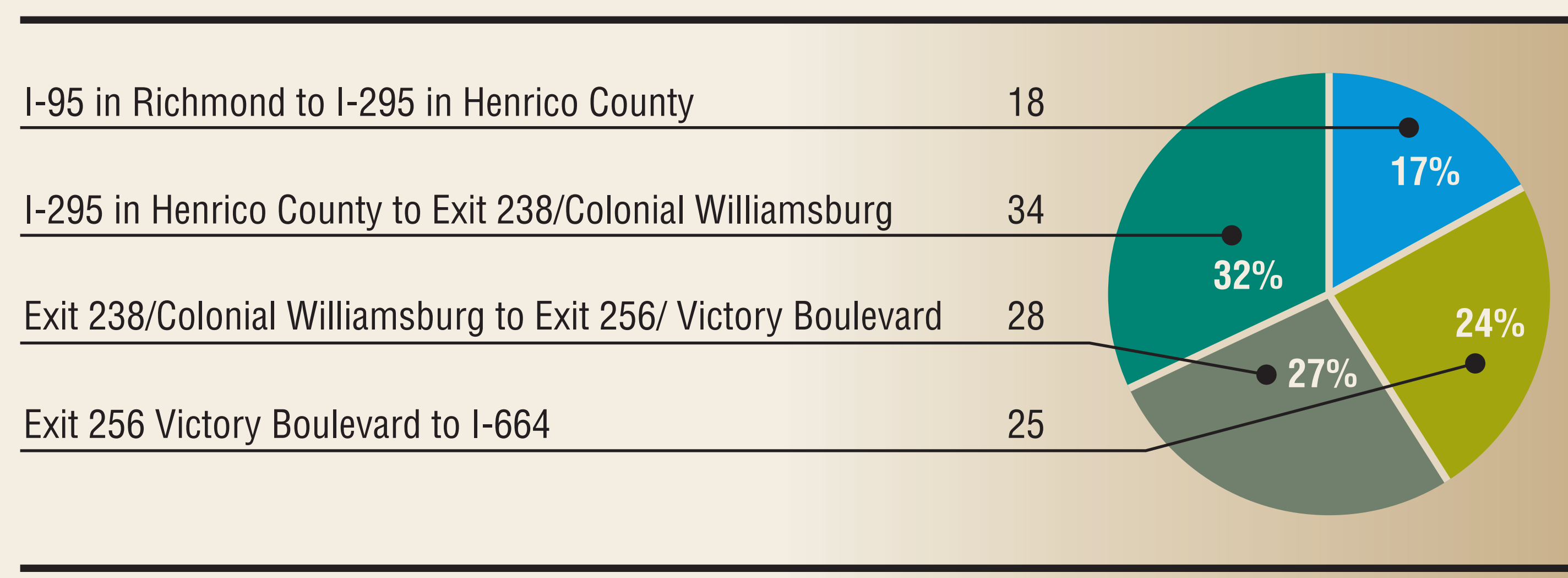

We took into consideration your comments and want to share with you some of the results from the comments we received.

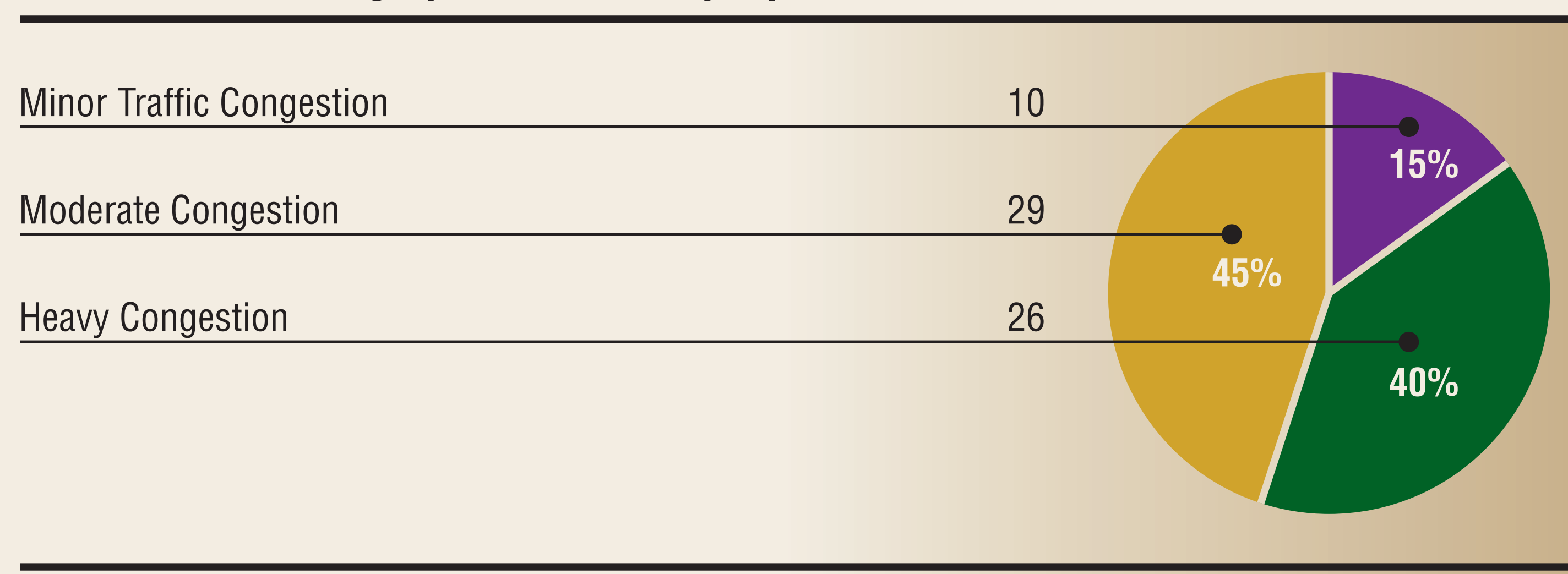
### QUESTION 1 – The main reason for traveling through the I-64 corridor is:



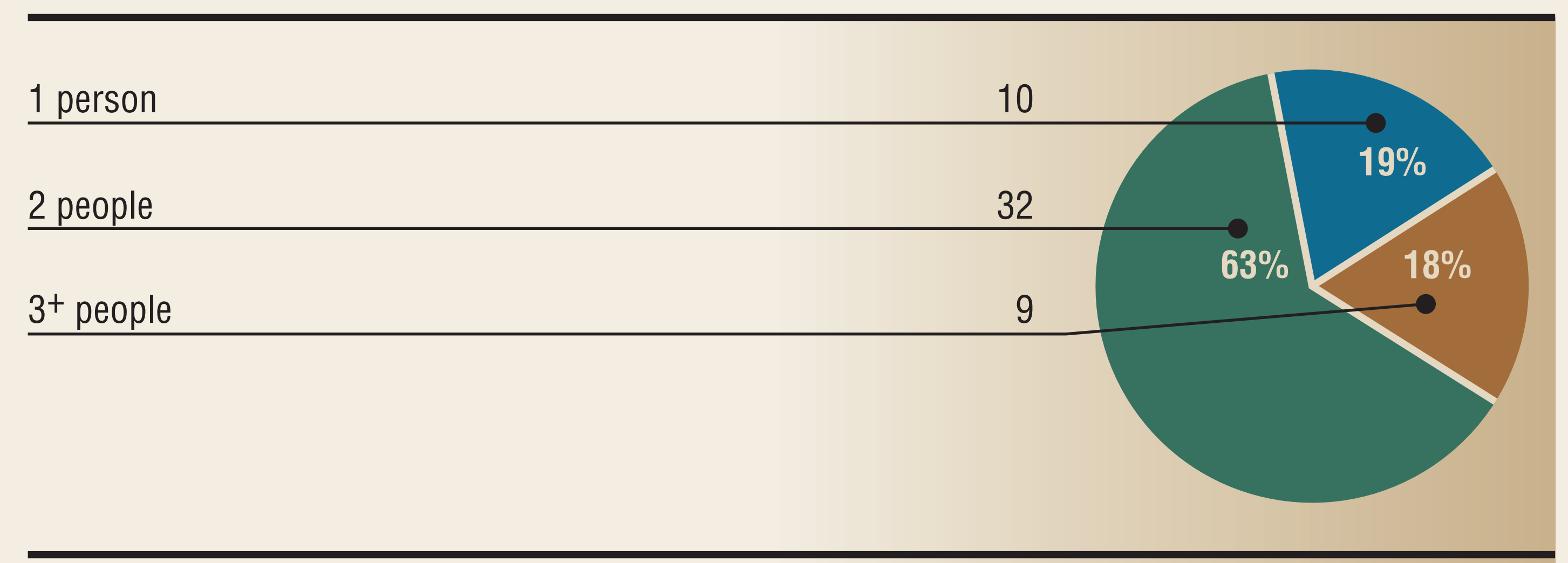
### QUESTION 2 – The section of the I-64 corridor I travel most often is:



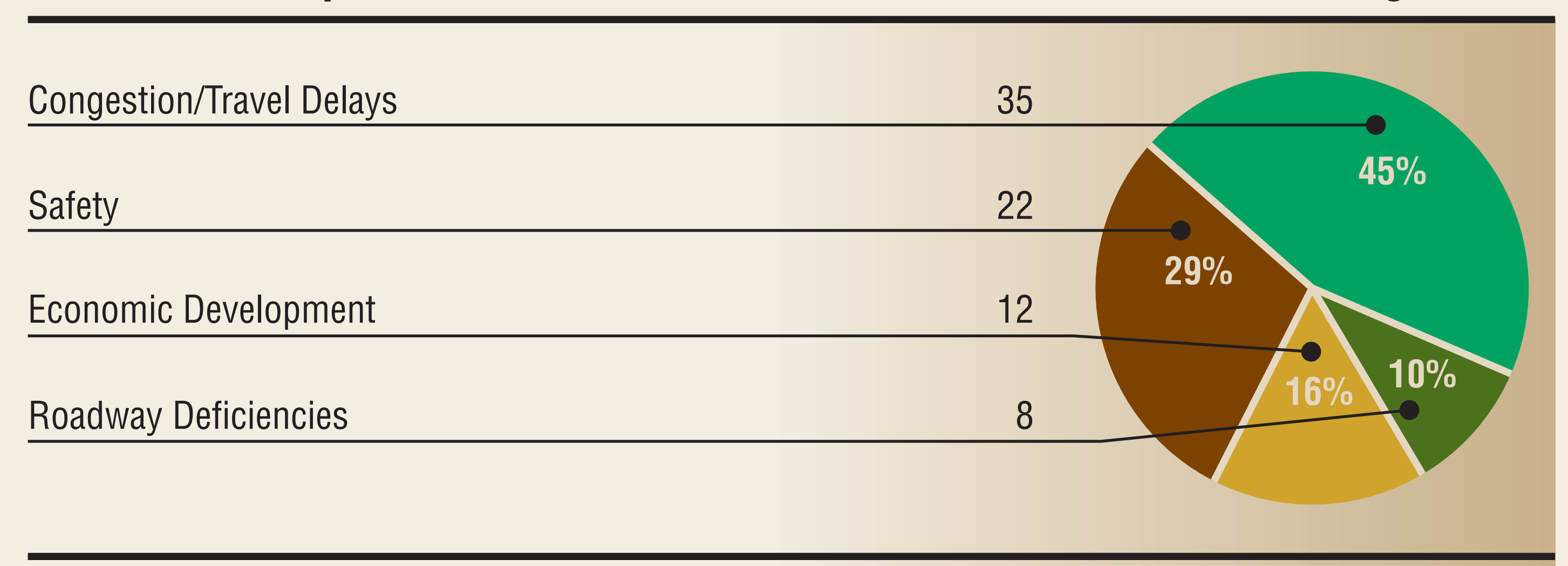
### QUESTION 3 – During my travel I normally experience:
